Dear Sir/Madam,

The Slovenian Rural Development Network and its partners are organizing the Festival of Slovenian Local Action Groups again this year. This year's theme of the Festival is natural and cultural heritage as an opportunity for rural development, which will be the main topic at the Friday conference, and the exhibitors in the Saturday part have also been invited to pay special attention to the topic in their presentations. The Festival will again have an international flavour with Local action groups from the neighbouring Croatia and other EU member states invited to take part.

The importance of natural and cultural values for the development of rural areas was shown in projects undertaken in the preceding planning period, and various EU funds (in addition to the CLLD, also the programme of cross-border and transnational co-operation etc.) are attaching great importance to them in the 2014-2020 planning period. It has encouraged us to add the Friday conference to the promotional part of the Festival. The central part of the conference has been designed so that in the first part the managers of selected successful projects will be invited to speak and discuss their experience. It will be followed by a presentation of sources of finance and recommendations to applicants and, in conclusion, new partnerships will be forged and topics set out (in a project exchange). The Friday events will end by an examination of good practice and an evening social event in the centre of the country's capital.

On Saturday, the Festival will move to the city centre of Ljubljana. Stands will be placed on Stritarjeva ulica and the Prešeren Square. You are kindly invited to participate also by bringing to the Festival - in addition to promoting your local action group or network - artists, folklore musicians, masters of crafts or other individuals from your location in order to present and describe the lesser-known jewels of natural and cultural heritage of your


